Call for Proposals

Every year, the city of St. Blasien and the Werbe- und Aktivkreis St. Blasien invite full-time artists to apply to participate in the International Sculpture Symposium. The event, which is known far beyond the borders of St. Blasien, will take place for the 26th time from **Sunday, 27 August to Sunday, 3 September 2023.** Work will be done under permanent tents in the streets of St. Blasien and on the cathedral square - in public and in front of the public. At the end of the week, the artworks will be presented on the Domplatz, where they will be auctioned off in a public auction on Sunday.

We look forward to receiving your application!

The call for entries and the necessary application documents for interested artists are available on the homepage **www.holzbildhauersymposium.de**. All professionally working artists are eligible to participate. The theme for the work proposal to be submitted can be freely chosen.

The city of St. Blasien will provide tree trunks (spruce only) between 160 and 220 centimetres high with a diameter of 40 to 60 centimetres. Other types of wood may be used, but must be organised and financed by the participants themselves. After consultation, the city of St. Blasien will provide a material cost subsidy of up to 200 euros.

Application deadline: 15 March 2023

An independent jury will make a selection from the submitted proposals at the end of March 2023. The selected applicants will be informed of the result. In addition, the result will be published on **www.holzbildhauersymposium.de**.

A publication presenting all participating artists and their works is planned. An artist's fee of 1200 euros gross will be paid at the end of the symposium and after completion of the work.
